This authoritative, highly acclaimed classic history of the Korean War is a dramatic and hard-hitting account of the conflict written from the perspective of those who fought it.

T. R. Fehrenbach's narrative brings to life the harrowing and bloody battles that were fought up and down the Korean Peninsula. Partly drawn from official records, operations journals, and histories, it is based largely on the compelling personal narratives of the small-unit commanders and their troops. Unlike any other work on the Korean War, it provides a clear panoramic view, sharp insight into the successes and failures of U.S. forces, and a riveting account of fierce clashes between U.N. troops and the North Korean and Chinese communist invaders.

The lessons that Colonel Fehrenbach identifies still resonate. Severe peacetime budget cuts after World War II left the U.S. military a shadow of its former self, and the United States was simply unprepared for war. And today, as Americans and North Koreans continue to face each other across the 38th parallel, *This Kind of War* is as relevant as ever, commemorating the past and offering vital lessons for the future.

T. R. Fehrenbach is a retired U.S. Army colonel who commanded units in Korea at the platoon, company, and battalion levels. He is the author of *Comanches*, *Lone Star*, and *Seven Keys to Texas*, and has contributed to numerous publications, including the *Atlantic*, the *Saturday Evening Post*, and the *New Republic*. He lives in Texas with his wife.

Kevin Foley has over thirty years' experience in radio and television broadcasting, commercial voice-overs, and audiobook narration. He has recorded over one hundred and fifty audiobooks, including the *New York Times* bestseller *The Politician* by Andrew Young and *The Most Dangerous Place* by Imtiaz Gul.
