But the rules have also changed in Jo Jo's classroom, where they have a substitute teacher. Since Jo Jo has a knack for being helpful, she puts her mind to helping her classmates decide on their talents—but can she follow the substitute teacher's rules?

Even if no one else understands Jo Jo's own rules (like that saying "please" makes words softer and fluffier to hear, and that square foods are too pointy to be yummy), her talent for celebrating and her curiosity keep her happily hop-skippping in step with her Ojibwe community.

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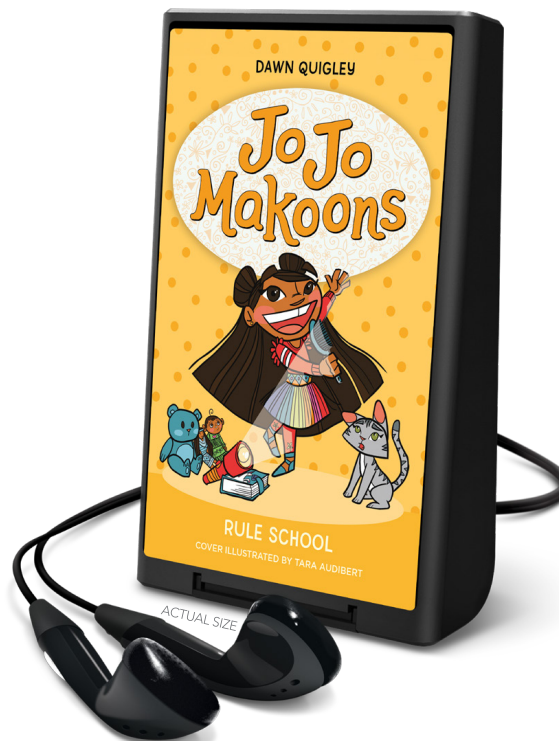
