Tim was diagnosed with ALS (amyotrophic lateral sclerosis) in August 2016. In November 2018, he launched a nonprofit online fundraising campaign called Tackle ALS, which has raised more than nine million dollars to directly support groundbreaking research at Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston. 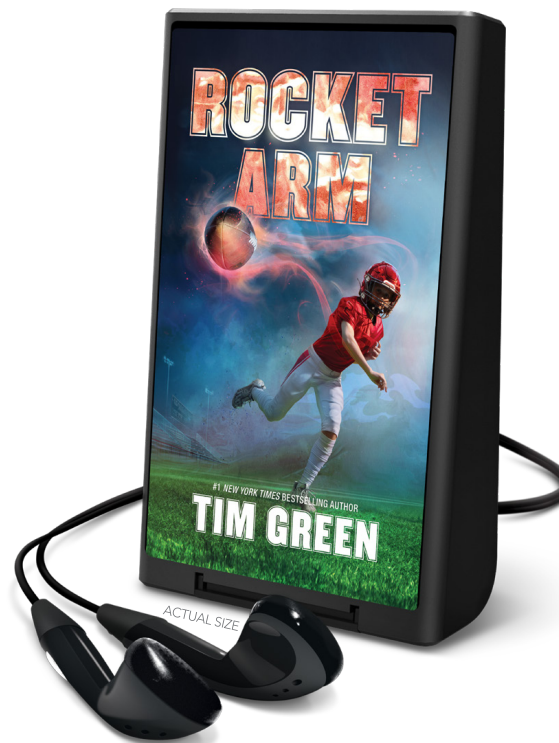
